Kang Chiao International School is a private co-education boarding school. It opened in September of 2014, while its Taipei campus was founded in 2002. It currently offers an overseas college preparatory program for Grades 6 -12.

Students are also given opportunities to undertake IB Middle Years Programme at Grades 9-10 and Diploma Programme at Grades 11 and 12.

Faculty and Students

KCISEC employs 138 foreign teachers. 50% (69/138) of the teachers are from the U.S.A. and Canada. The KCISEC student body consists of 87% Chinese, 9.5% Taiwanese and 3.5% other nationalities, including the U.S., Canada, England, Australia, Netherlands, Italy, France, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Hong Kong and Singapore.

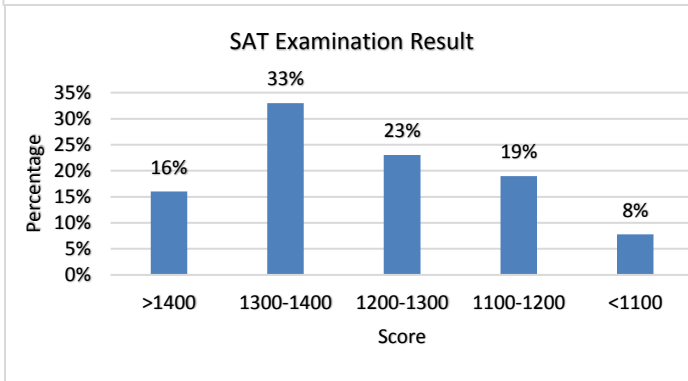
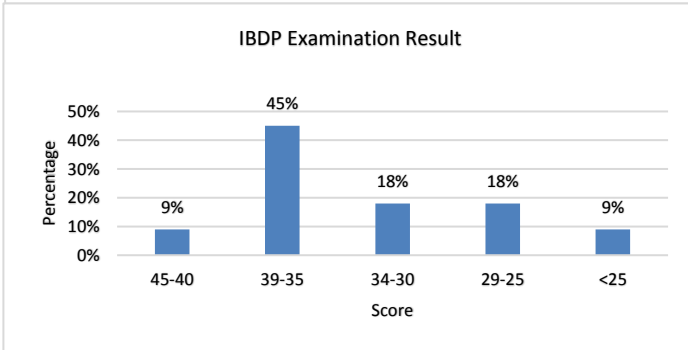
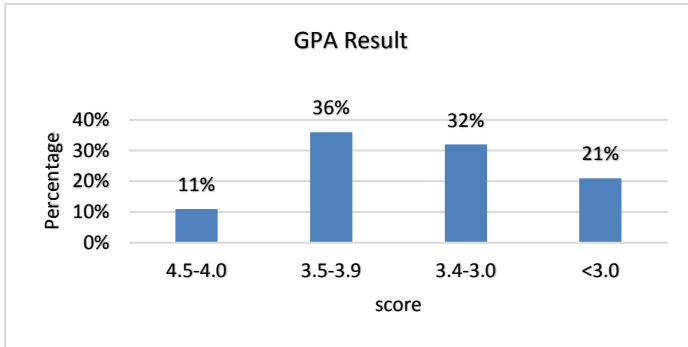
